
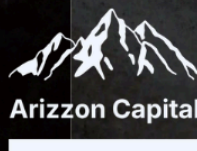

I. The Strategic Thesis

Today, April 21, 2026, Virginia stands at a jurisdictional crossroads. The special election referendum on **Map Sovereignty** represents a fundamental pivot from a bipartisan commission model to a "Reciprocal Partisan" model. If approved, the amendment authorizes **House Bill 29**, granting the General Assembly immediate authority to redraw congressional boundaries. For the **Ashburn Digital Corridor**, this is the formal expiration of the "Moderate Shield."

While the polls remain open until 7:00 PM ET, the "Geopolitical TIT FOR TAT" is already priced into the cloud sector's risk models. A "Yes" vote tonight signals that Virginia's regulatory environment has moved from predictable to partisan.
