## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Following the IP centralization detailed in Analysis No. 14, this briefing evaluates Alberta as the primary "Safe Harbor" for North American AI assets. As regulatory volatility increases in traditional tech hubs, Alberta's sovereign pivot offers a clinical de-risking strategy for HNW founders and institutional capital.

### I. THE SOVEREIGNTY SIGNAL: ATIS 2.0

On April 23, 2026, Minister Nate Glubish launched the **Alberta Technology and Innovation Strategy (ATIS) 2.0**.

- **Provincial Equity Stakes:** For the first time, **Alberta Innovates** and the **Alberta Enterprise Corporation (AEC)** have the authority to take minority equity stakes in local firms. This creates a "Sovereign Shield" that protects your IP from being stripped by foreign capital.
- **The IP Office:** A dedicated provincial office now exists solely to insulate made-in-Alberta innovation from federal or foreign jurisdictional creep.

## II. THE "GAS-VIA-FIBER" INFRASTRUCTURE

Alberta is transforming its energy legacy into digital power. As Minister Nate Glubish stated on **April 7**, data centers allow Alberta to "export our natural gas to global markets without having to move it" via fiber optics instead of pipelines.

- **The Olds Mandate:** Synapse Real Estate Corp has resubmitted its application for a **\$10-billion, 1GW data center complex** in Olds, with the AUC application process currently live as of April 2026.
- **The USMCA "Joint Review" Hedge: Article 34.7** of the USMCA mandates a formal review on **July 1, 2026**. This creates a "Data Sunset" risk where the US may push for residency constraints. Alberta's pivot to on-site energy-integrated compute acts as an insurance policy, ensuring your agents stay operational regardless of the trade outcome.

The "Safe Harbor" is now a regional fortress. The **SASK AI EXPO**, which concluded on **April 27, 2026**, in Saskatoon, solidified a Western Canadian Tech Bloc.

- **Industrial Application:** Saskatchewan is leading the "Application Layer" for mining and ag-tech AI, providing a high-value destination for the raw compute power generated in Calgary.
