I. THE SIGNAL: THE DEATH OF THE EXODUS

The "Exodus" narrative is a 2024 relic. In April 2026, San Francisco has reclaimed its status as the world's top startup ecosystem. While Hanoi serves as the engine room for physical compute, SF has re-solidified as the Governance and Capital Forge.

- **The Stat:** SF captured 27% of global VC investment through Q1 2026.
- **The Shift:** Leasing activity in the city hit 3.8 million sq. ft. in Q1—the strongest quarter since 2014—driven entirely by AI giants like OpenAI, Anthropic, and Databricks.

II. CEREBRAL VALLEY: THE RETURN TO ZIP CODE

Venture Capital in 2026 has officially ended the "Remote-Only" era for early-stage builds. Physical proximity in neighborhoods like Hayes Valley and SoMa (Cerebral Valley) is once again a prerequisite for elite-tier funding.
